## Important information for the Parents and Class of 2018

### Senior Scholarship Awards Program

Fill out the attached Senior Survey Award Recognition Form and return to Corinna Eppers in the Main Office by Tuesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>.

### Senior Final Exams

Senior final exams are Tuesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> during regularly scheduled class time. Periods 1, 3, 5, and 7 will be on May 29<sup>th</sup>. Periods 2, 4, and 6 will be on May 30<sup>th</sup>. Teachers may provide additional time outside these days for students to complete final exams/projects.

### Graduation Requirements

In order to participate in graduation, all students

- Must have completed their required credits set by Kenosha Unified School District, Policy 6456.
- Must pass the Civics exam. Civics exam given in U.S. Government & Politics course.
- Must also complete ten hours of community service to fulfill the graduation requirement. Students submitting 100 hours or more of community service will be receiving special recognition on their diploma if submitted by May 21.

### Last Day for Seniors – Wednesday, May 30

All seniors should make sure that all textbooks, library books, electronic devices, band/choir dresses and uniforms are returned. All fines and fees must be paid. This information is available in Infinite Campus or by calling 262-359-8707.

### Caps and Gowns

Caps and gowns were distributed on March 16<sup>th</sup> and April 12<sup>th</sup>. If you did not pick up your cap and gown, please stop by the Main Office. Any graduate wishing to donate their gown for future student usage may do so in the Main Office at a later time after graduation. Please keep in mind that graduation is a formal event so we ask that students refrain from decorating their caps.

### Graduation Rehearsal

Friday, June 1 – **Seniors participating in the graduation ceremony are required to attend rehearsal which begins in the Field House at 8:00 AM sharp.** Do not wear your cap and gown to rehearsal. Each graduate will receive five tickets for the ceremony. Please let Corinna Eppers in the Main Office know if you have any unused tickets by May 21<sup>st</sup>. If you are in need of extra tickets, please submit the request in writing to Corinna Eppers by May 22<sup>nd</sup>. All tickets will be given to students after rehearsal.

### Graduation Day

- Ceremony – Graduates need to report to the Field House by 5:30 PM sharp for the group photo. Late students **will not** be included in the group photo. All students must have cap with tassel, gown and medallion to participate in the graduation ceremony with exception of KMA students in uniform. Graduates are advised that **ONLY** school awarded medals may be worn.
- Diplomas will be distributed after the graduation ceremony.
- Seating for family and friends is by ticket only. Seating is not reserved; doors open at 6:00 PM. Special needs seating is available by calling 262-359-8677 in advance.
- Other viewing options – In addition to the Field House, the Auditorium will be open for guests to watch the live broadcast of graduation. No tickets are required to view from the Auditorium.
- Pictures – Lifetouch will be taking pictures of the graduate as they receive their diploma. The images will be available approximately seven days after the event. Photos can be viewed at: <http://events.lifetouch.com>. Students will receive additional information at rehearsal. In order to allow all parents and guests to view the ceremony, we ask that you remain in your seats during the ceremony. Photo opportunities will be available in the Field House after the ceremony.
- Parking is available in established lots directly west of Indian Trail with overflow parking at Mahone Middle School. The U-shaped drive by the flagpole may be used as a drop-off only. This area must be kept clear for emergency vehicles.
